- 33% FORMAT**
- Affidavit

33% Content: Reflects how much the report matches the bibliography. Evaluation of the content is based on the comprehension of the material as well as the student's synthesis skills and concept interaction. Report contents are valued only as 33% of the final grade because the textbook is available for the student throughout report elaboration.

Shows how the subject is mastered through case studies, personal comments, and the ability to apply the information learned to problem-solving. Evaluation of the PQT shows the student's analysis criteria and critical thinking, as reflected in the writing and presentation style.
